PLEASE

●	Golf shirts with collar & Sleeves	●	Hats or caps in the Clubhouse, baseball caps facing backwards
●	Roll neck sweaters	●	T-shirts or collarless/sleeveless shirts
●	Long trousers, plus twos or tailored knee length shorts	●	Shirts not tucked into waistband
●	Socks at all times, knee length, or predominantly white ankle socks, if worn with shorts	●	Beechshorts, sportshorts, denim wear, combat or jean style trousers
●	Golf shoes	●	Trousers tucked into socks (except plus twos/fours)
●	Smart casual dress or golfing attire during the day on the course or in the Clubhouse	●	Tracksuits, jogging suits, bomber type jackets
●	Jacket and tie for evening dining and on Sunday in the Lounge and the Dining Room	●	Short coloured socks with shorts, or socks pushed down on ankles
●	To change shoes in the changing rooms before and after playing golf.	●	Trainers, sandals, bare feet or footwear without socks
